

Importance of Border Communities

International cooperation.

- Multi-actor interventions to strengthen Lebanese security agencies' border management capacity
- interventions predominantly led by major Security Assistance providers such as the US, UK, and EU – are in many ways ad hoc and informed by geopolitics
- double coordination-complex.
- highly instructive in developing coordination practices at the ad hoc level.

- Build Social Safety Nets in areas dependent on smuggling.
- Increase Public Presence and Engagement in Border Communities.
 - Open Days.
 - Patrols to engage with residents, shop keepers, children, and pedestrians.
- Increase Female Presence in Communities.
 - Incorporate more female in all the Agencies community engagement efforts and other activities.
- Increase Communication that can Penetrate Family / Friends Networks
 - Post videos and content on Social Media groups (i.e. news, popular, community, and municipality groups) that people can forward to their friends and family.
 - Develop short videos that can be quickly and easily forwarded or shared across all social media platforms.
 - Create an Application that can be used anonymously.
