






What is at stake with General Aviation?

- Large variety of operations barely monitored
- Lack of or limited data regarding General Aviation activities
- · Operating in scattered areas, notably in border areas
- Atypical profile of General Aviation users
- Limited knowledge of this vector by LEA officers

National Technical Committees / Inter-Agency Working Groups (nationally steered processes, further improvements of resources,...)





No risk assessment












The COLIBRI mobile app
