Flow of Information in the context of border management:
the need to strengthen and streamline the information flow among border management actors.

Border management actors: Border Guards, Customs, Police, Revenue, Coast Guard, Sanitary, Health, Standards, Environment ...

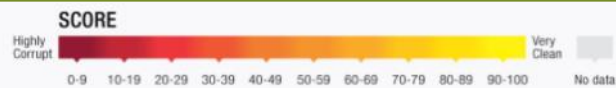
CORRUPTION PERCEPTIONS INDEX

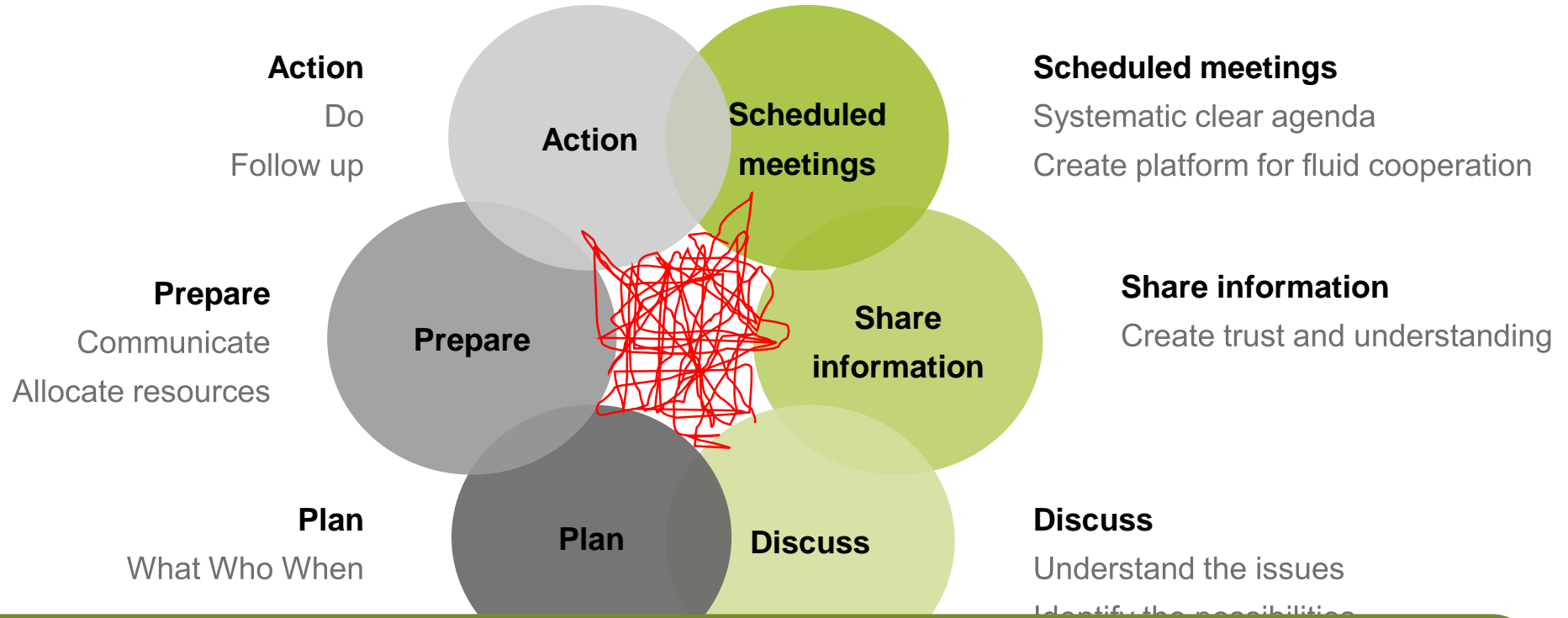
Myndigheter i samverkan mot den organiserade brottsligheten

- Agree on prioritization



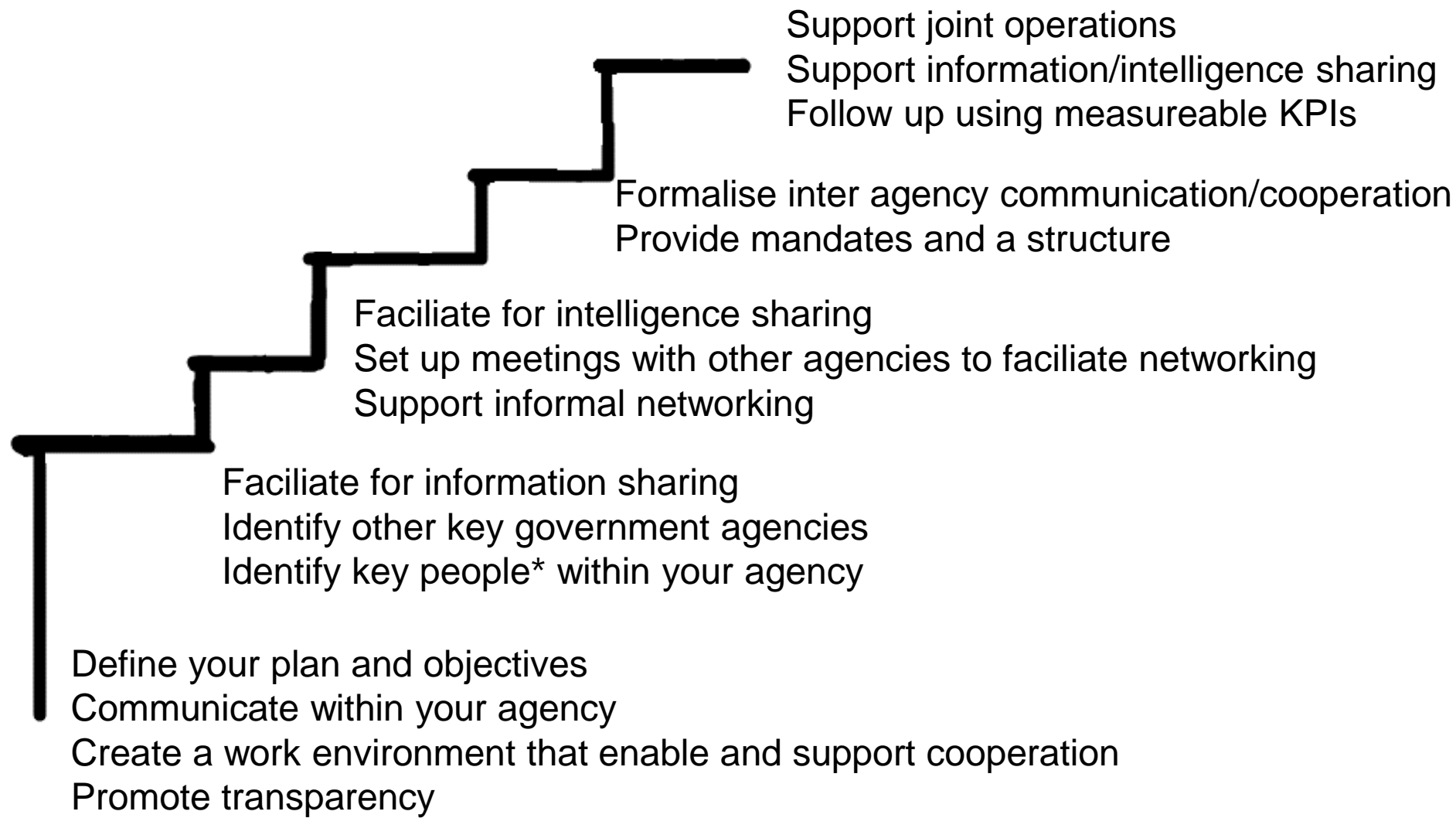
Network

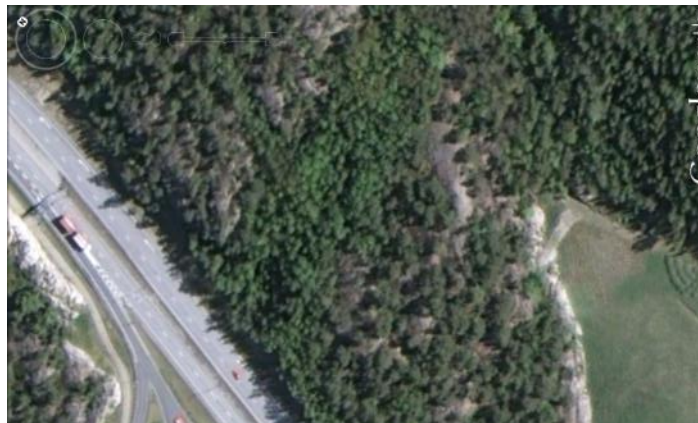
Border Management
