






PREVENTION AND RESPONSE LESSONS LEARNED




- Existing measures against the hybrid attack were not sufficient

- Sharing of intelligence, joint investigation cell in VIInius
- Prompt and effective sanctions for involved entities
- Is the current migration policy capable of tackling today's migration challenges?


FACILITATED IRREGULAR MIGRATION 2022 (Jan-Spt)


CONSTRUCTION OF THE PHYSICAL BARRIER

LAND BORDER SURVEILLANCE SYSTEMS



Systems allow to ensure surveillance of 70,5% of the border (756,65 km):

- > 100 % sea border (119,65 km)
- > 100 % border with RUS (275 km)
- > 53,3 % border with BLR (362 km)
