INTERNATIONAL THREATS



The main challenge for the Ukrainian state remains the aggression of the Russian Federation. We continue to feel the growth of the full range of hybrid threats at the eastern border, from **Russian-occupied** territories and at the border with the Russian satellite -**Belarus**

RESPONSE MEASURES







On the 10th of November, the National Security and Defense Council of Ukraine decided to strengthen the protection of the most vulnerable areas of the Ukrainian-Belarusian border and initiated a joint special border operation by SBGS, NP, NGU, Armed Forces of Uktaine and other.

POSITIVE EXPERIENCE



In September 2020, about 2,000 Hasidic pilgrims were stopped by Ukrainian border guards while attempting to cross the the border illegally

QUARANTINE-RESTRICTIVE MEASURES



In the condition of the threat of coronavirus infection spread, we have managed to maintain the control on the border, to ensure an adequate level of its security and to create safe conditions for work and service.

DIRECTIONS OF ACTIVITIES

Given the existing threats, we are actively working to:

organize and coordinate fruitful cooperation of all IBM actors in Ukraine

 to strengthen joint opportunities with the states of the European Union and Moldova on:

- increasing the number of border crossing points for joint control
- expanding the geography of joint patrols and joint contact points

 continue the development of international cooperation with our strategic partners - USA, Canada, Great Britain, Germany, Poland, Lithuania, FRONTEX Agency, NATO structures, EU Missions in Ukraine, to intensify joint risk analysis activities





INNOVATIONS

Modern automated border control systems with elements of artificial intelligence are being introduced:

•biometric verification and face recognition

 deployment of the subsystem "E-Gates", which will provide control without the participation of inspectors

 transition to "Electronic control coupon" systems and automated reading of vehicle license plates

•automatic risk profiling, verification of databases of persons, transport and documents, including INTERPOL, EUROPOL

modernization of video surveillance systems at border crossing points

In the future, these solutions are planned to be combined into a SINGLE SYSTEM







INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION





On the 30th of August 2021, it was signed an Intergovernmental Automated Targeting System Global (ATS-G) Agreement with the Government of the United States of America We continue to improve the interagency information exchange system "Arkan", to which 24 state institutions are already connected

AUTOMATION OF BORDER PROTECTION

An intelligent monitoring, control and tracking system has been set up along the green border, working 24 hours a day in all weather conditions (300 km of border within Kharkiv and Luhansk regions)

It was increased capacity of maritime domain awareness in the waters of the Azov and Black Seas. There were installed 7 modern posts of technical surveillance with Japanese radars on it (25 posts of technical surveillance)

The Government has approved the Concept of the state targeted law enforcement program in order to improve the engineering arrangement of the border





INTERNATIONAL ASSISTANCE

Under agreements with the Government of France, we have already received 2 modern Airbus Helicopter H125 (10 are expected by the end of the year, in total we plan to receive 24)



The work continues with partners from the United States, France and the European Commission to obtain 43 boats in order to strengthen the Marine Guard



UNMANNED AVIATION

In particular, I would like to highlight our successful efforts to develop unmanned aviation. 121 unmanned aerial vehicles (197 UAVs) and 9 systems for detection and response on unmanned aerial vehicle are used in border protection



With the support of our American partners, we opened the first UAV Operator Training Center in Ukraine



OPERATIONAL AND PREVENTIVE MEASURES

There were conducted 5 joint border operations (operational - preventive measures), including 2 - at the international level

«ZASLON», «ZUBR-2020», «MIGRANT», «COORDINATION POINTS. AIR AREA 2020», «CARPATHIANS – 2021». <u>"KORDON-20</u>21" is currently underway



Considerable attention is paid to recruiting and training, as a result - we received high marks during participation in joint international exercises «SEA BREEZE», "RIVERINE", "RAPID TRIDENT", "KOZAK MAYS" and "JOINED EFFORTS"



INTERNATIONAL ASSISTANCE

260 million UAH of international assistance was received for 10 months of 2021.

The project "EU Support in Strengthening Integrated Border Management in Ukraine" (EU4IBM) continues

The analysis of **23** business processes was completed, **14** reports with recommendations were approved, according to which **11** plans for implementation of recommendations were developed.
